Falcon: Self Sovereign Consent DNA (Bit Arrays/Bitmaps)


Assumption Blaster:

- Consumers can't know what 3rd Parties are using data
- Solutions can't adhere to all regulations
- We can't support asynchronous Identity
- Stored data can't be used the same as transactional data
- Consistent legal language is impossible
- Frequency capping isn't feasible







If calling party does specify a jurisdiction...




= 1 (that business may use that data for that program)






If user opts-in, all bits get flipped










If user globally opts-out for the company...




