



Technology Stack Working Group

- Current focus is the ToIP Technology Architecture Specification V1
- ToIP Technology Architecture Task Force is meeting twice each week (NA/EU at 14:00 UTC, APAC at 20:00 UTC)
- Have developed a generalized reference architecture for defining the four layers of the ToIP Technology Stack
- Wenjing Chu presented this reference architecture at the Internet Identity Workshop (IIW) April 26-28—it was very well received
- Now in the process of adding the details and requirements necessary to complete the V1 spec

Inputs & Semantics Working Group

Working Group Priorities

- Alignment of Dynamic Data Economy (DDE) models, concepts, and technologies with the more familiar Self-sovereign Identity (SSI) models.
- Continued use case alignment:
 - KERI (Inputs domain) and OCA (Semantic domain) principles
 - Data governance administrations (EU Data Gov. Act, MyData Operators, Data services/components, "Intermediaries")
 - Distributed data ecosystems
- DDE v1.0 and OCA v1.0 due for internal review end of May / early June which will likely trigger a migration of *Decentralised Semantics* to a more data-centric (as opposed to identifier-centric) community to maintain momentum
- Data Governance Compliance impact on SSI/DDE. Potential solutions.


