


#### Governance Stack Working Group

### Announcing the Governance Architecture Task Force

- After the original development of the ToIP Governance Architecture Specification and ToIP Governance Metamodel Specification, the plan had been to start creating **layer-specific templates**
- However the Governance Layer TF, lead by Alex Tweeddale, Carly Huitema, and Kyle Robinson—with input from Stephen Curran concluded that **component-based templates** made more sense
- Thus the new Governance Architecture TF will launch on **Sept 7** based on the components in the TAS




### Technology Stack Working Group


- Current focus is the ToIP Technology Architecture Specification V1
- Intensive meeting schedule twice every Thursday (NA/EU at 14:00 UTC, APAC at 01:00 UTC)
- Major progress on the spec—our goals now are:
  - Complete the main body of the spec **this month**
  - Resolve issues and complete wordsmithing in August
  - Launch the first Public Review Draft at the ToIP Mini-Summit (part of the LF Open Source Summit) in Dublin on Sept 14

- By the second week of August we should be ready for any ToIP member to review/comment on the draft ToIP Technology Architecture spec
- This is the time to provide any input! The concrete is still wet, but it will be drying fast
- Once the overall architectural requirements are set, we will begin working on test cases and more detailed layer by layer specifications

## Human Experience Working Group

### SSI Harms Task Force

**Deliverables:** White Paper and practical tools/guidance for ToIP members

White Paper Rough Draft available for internal review from 1st Week August. Reviews over August, then September finalise with aim of publishing in Oct or Nov.

Developing a **mental model** of how human harms function within a socio-economic-technical system in relation to concepts such as power, agency, livelihood assets, resilience and vulnerability. Considering both direct and indirect harms

Pyrou Chung in APAC group has had direct conversations with representatives from over 15 different indigenous groups so that the paper is grounded in lived experience and incorporates **grassroots perspectives** around their digital identities


### Concepts and Terminology Working Group



## Concepts & Terminology Working Group

- Continuing work on terms wikis and glossaries based on our Terminology Toolbox framework
- **NEW WORK**: We now have a volunteer development team (Sid Haniff, Prashant Rahulkar, and Partha Pal) and an architect (Rieks Joosten) for **Terminology Toolbox 2.0** 
  - Will support for automated ingestion of different term definition sources
  - Will produce glossary output documents from multiple sources
  - Will include authoring tools for automated markup of Markdown documents

## Terminology Toolbox 2.0 Architecture




### Proposed New Mental Model Task Force

- Mental models explain in detail how a set of concepts are related within a specific domain—a "mini-ontology"
- They are usually documented both in writing and in UML diagrams
- They add much greater depth and cross-conceptual understanding than glossaries alone
- The CTWG is proposing to start up a new Mental Models Task
   Force in September if there is sufficient interest

This is an example of the **Parties, Actors, and Actions** mental model developed by eSSIF-Lab.

It enables very precise descriptions of what types of entities take what types of actions in what kinds of relationships within a digital trust ecosystem.
