### Video Content

The HXWG is working on a introduction video.

Kalin and Nicky are paying for <u>Bluecarrot</u> to professionally produce the HX intro video which will necessarily include a short intro to ToIP, they will then **gift this to ToIP** as an asset.

The animation will be max 90 seconds long. Tim, from Bluecarrot, advised that we needed to be crisper on our key messages and reducing the length of the script. They will join the HXWG meeting next week and this will give them a chance to get a feel for the place and people, and also to share their initial recommendations on the script and some creative ideas perhaps.

There is a short cut to the powerpoint that the script will be based on, and the initial script document by HXWG in the folder Video Content in the Communications Committee Shared Drive.

The process should take ~6 weeks depending on how speedy we are in getting back to them at each stage of the process. Note: The developers, Both Tim and Ana are in Lviv, Ukraine so we are being flexible on delivery timelines.

### Ajay's Proposal - Update?

- Ajay offered create some videos, how do we want to proceed with that and creating an editorial calendar.
- 1. Use the TOIP Stack Design Principles as the theme for the video podcast.
- 2. So there can be 17 principle episodes and 1 context setting episode making it a total of 18 episodes.
- 3. Each episode will be under 5 minutes and explain the principle, illustrate it with a diagram, and help contextualize it through one or more real-world use cases.
- 4. I will shoot these episodes with a camera person from Angel and edit them before presenting it to the committee for a second round of edits/ fine tuning.
- 5. May I propose we do the first 5 sessions with John and Drummond so I can cover them in a two-day trip to Seattle and Vancouver.
- 6. They will both be interviewed for the context setting episode. John can do design principles #1 and #3, and Drummond can do #2 and #4.
- 7. We will do several takes and get into a rhythm and a format for the video podcast series.
- 8. They can be released bi-weekly and that will give us a chance to record and edit the next 5 or so where the TOIP expert can be different.
- 9. The subsequent ones can be recorded remotely.
