


Concepts and Terminology Working Group



Terminology Engine V2 (TEv2)

- ToIP member Brian Richter has accepted the bounty to develop the open source code for TEv2
- TEv2 will enable any terms communities (e.g., ToIP WGs or TFs) to generate a glossary from one or more **terms wikis**
- It will also automate hyperlinking terms within a specification, white paper, or other deliverable to their glossary definitions
- The Human Experience WG has already used TEv1 to generate a glossary for their Harms white paper
- Several TSWG TFs are planning to use TEv2 to publish the terminology for their specifications and papers

Terminology Toolbox 2.0 Architecture




Proposed New Mental Model Task Force

- Mental models explain how a set of concepts are related within a specific domain—a "mini-ontology"
- They are usually documented both in writing and in UML diagrams
- They add much greater depth and cross-conceptual understanding than glossaries alone
- The CTWG is proposing to start up a new Mental Models Task
 Force if there is sufficient interest see the proposed mission

This is an example of the **Parties, Actors, and Actions** mental model developed by eSSIF-Lab.

It enables very precise descriptions of what types of entities take what types of actions in what kinds of relationships within a digital trust ecosystem.





Governance Stack Working Group

- The Governance Architecture TF, has added John Phillips to its leadership team of Alex Tweeddale and Kyle Robinson. It focus is to create governance requirements for components such as Trust Registry and other roles being flushed out by the Technology Stack Working Group task forces.
- The **GSWG** is working on developing a full-blown ToIP Ecosystem model case "The Museum Pass" which can be used (similar to Microsoft's Contoso) to demonstrate governance processes in a simulated structure.
- The GSWG is working on a whitepaper comparing and contrasting its Governance metamodel with the IEEE Blockchain for Governance.


Ongoing work items (Unchanged since the last report):


- Governments initiatives are gaining traction






