eIDAS (electronic IDentification, Authentication and trust Services) is an EU regulation on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the European Single Market

Q&A:

During the Q&A, it was asked if eIDAS will work on iOS devices and the answer was "yes". Later in the chat, Daniel Bachenheimer asked if iOS apps could access NFC and I replied that they could ... but that has some caveats.

As of iOS 14, apps can read / write NFC tags (see [Apple Core NFC](#)). However, an issue in the EU has been on whether 3rd party apps can send/receive NFC payments (see [EU Targets Apple Pay's Exclusive Access to iPhone NFC Chip](#)). Last year, Apple started allowing some 3rd party apps to accept NFC payments (see [Tap to Pay on iPhone](#)).

From what I'm reading, adding the NFC payment capability to your app requires special approval. I'm not sure how any of this enables/hinders NFC-enabled identity apps. Hopefully, that clarifies things somewhat.
