
Thoughts:

- We're talking at 3 levels:
 - o Profiles Being able to talk to a DID and say "so, what do you support?" helps create the interactions that we need.
 - o TIP Trusted Input Protocol a generic pattern of getting information (inputs) to make trust decisions/
 - Trust Registry Inputs (outputs of Trust Registries) focused on getting data out of systems-of-record that already exist (or that are being created)
- Parallel Efforts (see SSHOT 3)
 - These three things aren't in conflict and can be worked in parallel




1 - Summary Diagram




2 - Noodling Diagram
