Word docs, Evernote files, email, PDFs, even Post-it notes. It's scattered among different systems. And to make matters worse, <i>the stuff your teammates need is equally siloed</i>. If information had feelings, it would be lonely.</p> <p>But with Confluence, you can bring all that information into one place.</p>
<a href="#">Confluence 101: discuss work with your team</a>	<p>Getting a project outlined and adding the right content are just the first steps. Now it's time for your team to weigh in. Confluence makes it easy to discuss your work - with your team, your boss, or your entire company - in the same place where you organized and created it.</p>
<a href="#">Confluence 101: create content with pages</a>	<p>Think of pages as a New Age "document." If Word docs were rotary phones, Confluence pages would be smart phones. A smart phone still makes calls (like their rotary counterparts), but it can do so much more than that</p>
