## Notes

- Did the antitrust and IP announcement.
- We have done formats & signatures, and at IIW presentation protocols were "tackled".
- We need to do issuance protocol. WACI Pe-X does have that as future work. The group doing that work thought that it was out of scope for the initial work, and that it should be easily added in once the initial work is done.
- Drummond mentioned that this was done because while there are methods for issuance, presentation was what was needed for interoperability.
- We discussed how to handle the approaches for issuance; Aries and SVIP are two options.
- Kaliya brought up the point of the case where someone is starting from scratch — we should have an opinion. Brent said that the decision is probably language based in terms of the technical stack.
- We discussed how verifiable digital passes are issued. We'd like it to match up with paper. It was suggested that it be done with verifiable credentials without the need for ZKP. Correlation is also less of an issue as the expectation is that this is only being used once (or for one journey).
- There needs to be a discussion with Paper Credentials. They are going to be invited to Wednesday's meeting.
- We had a discussion around the 30-day targets. For the 30-90-180 days, we are moving towards the "MUST" state of requirements.
- For those that are just starting out, they should be considering the MUSTs now in terms of what they are building. New projects should implement the desired end state.
- We had a discussion about the timing for WACI Pe-X issuance protocols to determine if it is possible within the timeline. We want to put a stake in the ground.
- Riley was asked to provide additional language regarding issuance in our recommendations.
