



2. 5 m in	"terms wikis" or "term wiki"— which do you prefer	Drum mond Reed	<ul> <li>Should it be singular or plural?</li> <li>Judith Fleenor Is the plural for all of the different wikis?</li> <li>Daniel Hardman The question is: what does an individual wiki contain? But will go with what actually feels more natural.</li> <li>Brian Dill Okay with "terms wikis"</li> <li>Rieks Joosten Thinks that for accuracy, "terms wiki" is fine. But whatever we decide is fine. Agreeing on the concept is most important.</li> <li>Drummond Reed shared that "terms wiki" feels awkward. The singular felt more natural.</li> <li>Judith Fleenor people will shorten it the way that we will.</li> <li>Line Kofoed noted that "-terms" is the suffix already being used.</li> <li>Drummond Reed noted that W3C specs are able to auto-link terms based on a separate terminology document that accounts for plurals—we could eventually do the same here</li> <li>Rieks Joosten noted that this auto-linking can work 95% percent of the time but can also be faulty, so authors need to be able to override it</li> <li>DECISION: We will adopt the term "terms wiki"</li> </ul>

2 0 m in	Terms Wikis: current state and next steps	Danie I Hard man Rieks Joost en Drum mond Reed	<ul> <li>Daniel Hardman to report on his progress on defining Terms Wikis <ul> <li>His first step was to rename the main page from "Glossary Wikis" to "Terms Wikis"</li> <li>He also created four sub-pages with instructions</li> <li>He suggests that we record a &lt;10 min video of orientation and instructions</li> </ul> </li> <li>Rieks Joosten also did more work on the content of the pages Daniel added</li> <li>He started creating links to the CTWG terms wiki</li> <li>This led to an expansion of some terms on the CTWG's own terms wiki</li> <li>Authors are going to want to link to terms across multiple terms wiki</li> <li>So what is missing right now is the loop that will import that terms they need from all relevant terms-wikis in the provided by the ToIP Term tool</li> <li>That will be provided by the ToIP Term tool</li> <li>That will be provided by the ToIP Term tool</li> <li>The ultimate links that authors should use should not be to the terms wiki vs. linking to a term definition in the ToIP corpus</li> <li>Dunmond Reedsaid that he's fine with temporarily linking to the terms wiki as long as we have a clear plan and roadmap for migrating to permalinks to our terminology corpus as soon as possible.</li> <li>Daniel Hardman showed an example of the DIDComm spec at DIF (see screenshots #1 and #2 below) and authors having to cite flies in Gill-tub until they had a generated document to link to.</li> <li>Daniel suggests that we should quickly solve this problem by adding a scripting capability to generate the permanent glossary with the associated permalniks.</li> <li>The first step in the ToIP Term tool could start with the assumption that all the terms in a particular term wiki are the complete glossary (ignoring cross-linking of glossaries for now) in order to solve the permalink problem.</li> <li>Nicky Hickman liked the idea of a "quick-and-dirty" solution for permalinks. But she warms that we need to keep the editing and viewing processes that are simple as possible to use.</li> <li>Rieks Joosten from Code Compl</li></ul>
2 0 m in	Concepts and mental models: how do they fit?	Drum mond Reed Line Kofoed	<ul> <li>Is a rich mental model itself a scope? Should it have its own term wiki?</li> <li>How should the diagrams and "core conceptual model" be handled in relation to a term wiki?</li> <li>Rieks Joosten shared that "a pattern is not very different from a terms definition" - it just has other content <ul> <li>For the moment he doesn't expect these models to need the same machinery</li> <li>The challenge will be the pictures - how do you capture the diagrams</li> <li>That's a general problem that we will need to solve</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
2. 5 m in	"yoma-gf-terms" or "yoma-terms"	Drum mond Reed Nicky Hickm an	<ul> <li>Does the YOMA GF need its own term wiki? Or could the name be simplified (to avoid confusion)?</li> <li>We ran out of time to discuss this, but Nicky indicated a preference to "keep it simple" and just got with "yoma-terms"</li> <li>ACTION: Drummond Reed to confirm this with Nicky Hickman</li> </ul>

#### **Decisions**

• DECISION: The CTWG will adopt the term "terms wiki" (in the plural form) as the name for this new method for a group to curate a set of terms.

#### **Action Items**

- ACTION: Daniel Hardman by the next meeting (if not earlier) will write a script hooked up to GitHub Actions that will auto-generate a glossary artifact from the current state of a terms wiki that will be suitable for hyperlinking (and ideally permalinking) by authors who need to reference these terms.
- ACTION: Drummond Reed to confirm with Nicky Hickman that the YOMA terms wiki will use the prefix yoma-terms instead of yoma-gf-terms.
